Uniform	Expectation
Mark Rutherford School Black skirt (and black opaque tights) and Mark Rutherford School trousers (girls)	Only Mark Rutherford School uniform worn.
Black trousers (boys)	No jeans
White traditional shirt	With collar, buttoned to neck, accompanying school tie, shirt must be long enough to tuck in
Blue polo shirt (summer term only)	Worn in house colours with blazer
Black blazer with school name badge	Sleeves must be rolled down
Black V neck jumper	V neck and may have the school logo. Worn under blazer no cardigans
School Tie	Worn correctly in your house colours
Black school shoes	No trainers, plimsolls or boots
No facial piercings may be worn	Only one small pair of stud earrings may be worn
Hair	Natural in colour, no extremes in style, tracks or shaving.
