INTRODUCTION

The iMedia course is very useful if you are considering a career in the IT sector. The UK is a world leader in the creative digital industries, such as in the creation of visual effects for films and computer games. The UK has a well-deserved reputation for producing innovation and design; however, in an era in which creativity is intertwining with technology like never before, there is a danger that the UK will fail to nurture the next generation of world class designers. Creative iMedia will equip learners with a range of creative media skills and provide opportunities to develop, in context, desirable, transferable skills such as research, planning, and review, working with others and communicating creative concepts effectively.

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

You will learn to create fit for purpose creative media products.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED

iMedia consists of one externally assessed written paper which accounts for 20% of the qualification. The other units make up the other 80% and are internally assessed. Grades are awarded at Pass 1, Merit 1, Distinction 1, Pass 2, Merit 2, Distinction 2 and Distinction* 2 (1 being level 1 and 2 being level 2 which tie in with the new GCSE 9-1 grades).

Core Units:

R081: Pre-production skills- Assessment type: external written paper (20%)

This unit will enable students to acquire the underpinning knowledge and skills needed to create digital media products and gain an understanding of their application. On completion of this unit, students will be able to plan the pre-production of a creative digital media product to a client brief, and will understand how to review pre-production documents.



R082: Creating digital graphics – Assessment type: internal centre assessed

The aim of this unit is for learners to understand the basics of digital graphics editing for the creative and digital media sector. They will learn where and why digital graphics are used and what techniques are involved in their creation.
