## ASDAN Certificate

### INTRODUCTION

The Certificate of Personal Effectiveness (CoPE) programme is designed to enable young people to understand themselves and others better, whilst preparing them for the transition into adult life. It will equip them with valuable skills useful for school life and the world of work, and will enable them to contribute positively to all aspects of society in general.

The programme consists of a series of challenges and activities, which gives students the opportunity to evidence their Key Skills development whilst gaining credits for successfully completed tasks. The thematic design of each module allows students to build on current knowledge and progressively develop their personal and interpersonal skills.

You will be assessed by internal and external moderation of your portfolio. You will need to complete both class-based and homework tasks as part of your portfolio development. All work completed will form part of your evidence portfolio.

The Certificate of Personal Effectiveness will enable you to:

- Recognise personal achievements
- Effectively manage your learning
- Develop employability skills and personal effectiveness
- Achieve a Certificate in Personal Effectiveness at Level 1 or Level 2 (equivalent to one GCSE)

Students may wish to progress to CoPE Level 3 after completing Level 2.

### FURTHER INFORMATION
